**2010 COMMUNITY GRANT-IN-AID APPLICATIONS**

**Deadline December 31, 2009**

Non-profit or registered charitable organizations providing community programs in the areas of health, social and cultural services, events and festivals, and youth activities are eligible to apply for District of Sechelt funding under its 2010 Grant-in-Aid program.

Ensure you submit all the requested information, including audited financial statements, organization/project budget and a list of Board members/officers, so that your application can be properly considered.

Early in 2010, Council will be reviewing its Grant-in-Aid policy to develop an updated version that addresses the changing financial circumstances the District and many community service organizations are facing. Following the policy review, there will be an opportunity for all eligible organizations applying for grants to make presentations regarding their funding requests at a Committee of the Whole meeting. The District anticipates these meeting(s) will be held in February or March 2010. Applicants will be contacted and offered an opportunity to schedule a time for their presentation.
