

Torch Relay Times and Locations

VANOC will not confirm the exact times and locations until the media briefing on Feb 2nd so please be advised that the following are close but could be out by a few minutes and the route is subject to change right up to the event day.

The Torch Route travels from Earls Cove to Langdale. When the Torchbearers are carrying the torch, the best viewing for spectators will be on the righthand side of the road. (Hint: look for the orange markers on the roadside to locate points where the Torch will be passed from runner to runner)

Pender Harbour

The “Harbour Spirit Shines” in two celebrations. Pender Harbour El. – Sec. School starting at 8:30 am. Torch arriving at 8:57 am and Madeira Park Community Hall starting with a Lion’s Club Loggers Breakfast 8:00 – 11:00 am. Torch arriving at 9:05 am. Live Music...Let’s celebrate.

Sechelt

Torch arriving at West Sechelt Elementary at 10:05 am and will be run from the School down Norwest Bay Rd. and along Hwy 101 to Spirit Square. (See Sechelt’s Community Celebration doc.) Torch leaves the stage at Spirit Square at 11:27 am and run to SIGD arriving at 11:47 am for a 10 minute stop and celebration.

Torch again touches down on Hwy 101 at Selma Park Rd. at 12:05 pm and will run to McCullough Rd. in Wilson Creek arriving at 12:45 pm.
