GENERAL VOTING DAY

General day will be open to qualified electors of the District of Sechelt on **Saturday, November 15, 2008** between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 pm at the following locations:

West Sechelt Elementary School, 5609 Mason Road, Sechelt
Davis Bay Elementary School, 5078 Davis Bay Road, Sechelt

VOTING DAY REGISTRATION

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. All voters, both Resident Electors and Non-Resident Property Electors will be required to **produce 2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) that provides evidence of the applicant's identity and residency.

Voters will be required to make a declaration that they meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older
- Canadian citizen
- Resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day
- Resident of OR registered owner of real property in the District of Sechelt for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day, and
- Not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Non-Resident Property Electors

In addition to the above, Non-Resident Property Electors must provide:

- proof of property ownership by producing copy of property title or current Land Title Office search, registered agreement for sale, or 99 year lease document. **Tax or BC Assessment documents are not acceptable.**
- written consent from a majority of the other registered owners of the real property authorizing you to vote which must be on the prescribed form obtained in advance from the Chief Election Officer or designate at the District of Sechelt office during regular office hours prior to 4:30 pm on Friday, November 14, 2008 or at one of the voting locations **provided you have the required documentation listed above.** Forms are available from the District of Sechelt by mail, fax, email or at the District's web site at www.sechelt.ca

Advance Voting Opportunities

Advance voting opportunities will be held at the **Seaside Centre, 5790 Teredo, Sechelt** on **Wednesday, November 5, 2008** and **Friday, November 7, 2008** between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 pm each day.

Special Voting Opportunity

Special voting opportunities will be provided: Thursday, November 6, 2008 from 1 pm to 2 pm at Shorncliffe Residential Care Facility, 5847 Medusa Street; Wednesday, November 12, 2008 from 10:30 am to 11:30 am at Totem Lodge, 5544 Sunshine Coast Highway, Sechelt; and Wednesday, November 12, 2008 from 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm at St. Mary's Hospital, 5544 Sunshine Coast Highway, Sechelt.

Only those persons who are residents, patients or staff of the facilities at the time of voting may vote at these special voting opportunities.
